The Ascended Jesus

Hebrews 4:14-5:2

Jesus has ascended to the Father... So what?

Dear tired, struggling Christians, take heart because...

- (1) Jesus secures our forgiveness before God in the heavens (Heb. 4:14)
- (2) Jesus is a high priest who knows our weaknesses (Heb. 4:15; 5:2)
- (3) Jesus is even now praying for us in our struggles (Heb. 7:25)

Conclusion: The Ascended Jesus – Good News!

Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

- 1. How do you understand the idea that Jesus has ascended and is not physically with us now? What are some common struggles Christians face here?
- 2. What are some things that discourage you from drawing nearer to God your Father? Why?
- 3. What difference does it make to know that Jesus sympathizes with our weaknesses (Heb. 4:15; 5:2)? How does that help you run to Him?
- 4. Jesus is even now praying for us in our struggles (Heb. 7:25) do you believe this? How does this assure your heart?

Our World

Indonesia – Pray for 14 of our missiology alumni (and 16 children) who are gathering next month for an annual retreat to share and encourage one another in their personal walk and work in the harvest field. Pray for a good time of fellowship and spiritual encouragement with the ZB team that is going. Pray that the planned training in areas such as "Business as Mission", "My Spiritual Journey", and "A Biblical response to persecution" will be useful and relevant. May all attendees continue to draw closer to Jesus as they seek to be salt and light in the communities they are in.

Philippines – Student Missionary Outreach (SMO) missionary Ps Noel and 2 others in his team have been serving among the Tau't Bato people in the mountain area of Palawan, a northern island of the Philippines. Thank God that a small love gift from our church was able to support some of their programmes in reaching out to them. They have been conducting home bible studies, a feeding programme and also giving some clothes and medicines for the people in certain villages. There are some churches in this community and it is their hope that more Tau't Bato villages will be reached. Pray for them to continue to persevere in nurturing the Jesus followers already there to reach those who do not yet know Jesus in their own people group.

A Word in Season

The Trustees of Zion Bishan BP Church

Today at ACM, communicant members will be voting in new Trustees for Zion Bishan.

What exactly is the role of a Trustee? Under our Constitution, immovable property acquired by the Church (e.g. the Church's land lease) is vested in Trustees subject to a Declaration of Trust. The Trustees hold such property for the benefit of the Church.

Trustees are elected to hold in trust this property and to act as signatories in matters relating to the buying and selling of said property. An important thing to note is that all decisions to transact church property are first voted on at Congregational Meetings, before the Trustees sign in accordance with what was decided by the wider Church Body. To be clear, Trustees do not have the authority to buy or sell church property on their own accord, even if all Trustees agree to do so.

The Church is required to have a minimum of two Trustees and may elect a maximum of four. Our three current trustees are Elder John Chai, Elder Hun Ah Kuan and Elder Sonny Tan. We are thankful for the many years of their faithful stewardship in this role.

With the fresh lease renewal, they have indicated that they will step down for younger Elders to assume the role. Hence, Session is proposing to elect three new trustees in their place.

Why are Elders the ones to fulfil this role? It is because they are elected overseers of the Church Family, and are required by Scripture to be men of godly character. Also, as Session members, they will be informed of the background of matters regarding Church property.

Taking a moment to reflect on Trusteeship is important to us as we consider again that the Lord has clearly entrusted this piece of land into our hands for the next 30 years or until Jesus returns, just as He has entrusted us all to be good stewards of our time, abilities and the Good News of His Son.

As we begin this new lease, may each and every one of us, not just the three new Trustees, be found faithful stewards of this land by what we do on it each week – lifting high the Name of Jesus!
