Though this is a hopeful sign, it remains to be seen if both sides will truly make real progress towards a lasting peace. Pray that both parties which have been hurt greatly in this conflict will have the grace and forgiveness necessary to make peace. May the peace of God rule over the bitterness, hurt and despair there.
