Questions for Reflection & Discussion:

- 1. Think about or describe the most beautiful place you have ever seen. What role (if any) did humans play in making that place beautiful (or not)?
- What does it mean for humanity to be made in the image and likeness of God (1:26)? How does the poem that follows add to this understanding of the image of God (1:27)?
- 3. Why should Christians care about God's creation? What similarities and differences do you see between Christian stewardship of creation, and secular environmental activism or conservation movements?
- 4. In the light of what you have learned, how can you reflect God's image in practical ways during the next seven days in: a) your family; b) your church or small group; c) your work or study; d) your interaction with creation?

Created in His Image

Genesis 1:1-2, 1:26-2:1

Recap: God's Intro to God's People:

- i. The God who is the Powerful Creator: The Only and Holy Uncreated One
- ii. The Creator God who is committed to multiplying and filling His Created Order
- iii. The Creator God who Creates through Speaking (through His Word)

The Structure:

A: [1:26-27] Then God said, "Let *Us* make man in *Our* image [and] let *them* have dominion....so God created Man in His own image..."

B: [1:28] And God blessed them. And God said to them,

"Be fruitful and multiply and fill the Earth, subdue it and have
dominion..."

C: [1:29-30] And God said, "Behold I have given...And it was so."


The Declaration: [1:31]

And God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good.

3 Observations:

- **1. We are created in His Image**: Why God's intro matters to God's People (Moses' generation & every generation since)
- **2. The original Creation Mandate:** Blessed -> Be Fruitful and Multiply and Fill the Earth; Subdue it and have dominion...
- **3. Why the plurals matter:** Let *Us* make man in *Our* image [and] let *them* (*male* & *female*) have dominion... (1:26-27)

Conclusion: God's very good Creation and His Image-Bearing People Today...



- Colossians 1:9-23: Jesus: THE Image of the invisible God (v15)
- Ephesians 1:3-10: Jesus & Us: God's Plan from before the foundation of the Earth (v4)
- Ephesians 3:14-21: Jesus & Us: How God is glorified throughout all generations! (v20-21)

Questions for Reflection & Discussion:

- Come up with a definition of what it meant in Genesis 1 to be an image-bearer of God.
 What would it have looked like for Adam and Eve to obey God's original Creation
 Mandate to be fruitful, multiply and fill the earth, to subdue it and have dominion
 over it?
- 2. How does being made in God's Image and the original Creation Mandate shape our lives as believers today? What does this exactly look like in our lives post-fall and in light of Christ? How is it different compared to the original Creation Mandate?
- 3. Why do the plurals in today's passage matter to us as the corporate Body of Christ today? How does being made male and female make a difference to how we are God's Image-bearers and our purpose today as the Church?

Prayer Points

Our Church

Many are told to seek refuge and start stockpiling non-perishable food in case of an all-out war. Pray for our partner here who is persevering with summer children and youth programmes despite all these challenges. Pray for the situation to de-escalate so that all-out war can be avoided.

Marking Another Milestone

Over the last 2 months, I celebrated two big milestones: 15 years on staff at Zion Bishan, and the 12th anniversary of my ordination as a Minister of the Gospel. This prompted much reflection...

For those who didn't know, my first career was in research. I trained as a scientist and spent 4 years working in a hospital laboratory in central London, developing viral vectors for gene therapy.

During that time, God was doing His work. He brought me back to church, showed me who Jesus is - ever so personally, and made me excited about the gospel and His kingdom.

As I turned my eyes upon Jesus, indeed the things of the world – including my scientific pursuits and career ambitions – grew strangely dim. All I wanted was to get to know Jesus better.

That began the unexpected path into full-time ministry. Through a series of miraculous events, I ended up as an apprentice at All Souls London, and trained under incredible pastors for 2 years.

Unfortunately, the UK then changed its visa policy. We were forced to leave. It was crushing. However, God timed it perfectly. At that time Zion Bishan was on a path of renewal and searching for new staff. Things came full circle & God brought me home. It was an exciting time. I anchored the 'outreach' portfolio. We started up Christianity Explored, Goody Bag door-to-door visits, and even a chess ministry! Yet what bore most fruit, was meeting up with small groups of guys, 1 on 3. We met every week, read the Bible, studied theology and shared life – it was so encouraging to see them grow, as did I. They are still so dear to me.

Despite not knowing what to do most of the time and feeling significantly inadequate the rest - God did the work, not me. God brought in the people, the resources, even the money – and He built up His church... but more than that, He built up me.

Indeed what a privilege it is to serve the Lord in this capacity, so much He will show you, so much of Jesus you will see! I have much more to say, but now no time & space for long story... so till next time & to God be the glory!
