They are also praying for more brothers and sisters to join the church and to be convicted to serve the Lord there.

Our World

Nepal – A team of 2 from our church left this week to visit our partner. They will be helping to encourage the youths in our partner's community to follow and love the Lord more. Pray for journey mercies for the team and for them to be in good health. May they be blessed by all that they will be experiencing and learning from the Lord in this trip. Pray for open hearts to God's word for all the youths engaged with them in their time in Nepal so that they will grow in their love for their neighbours.

Typhoon Yagi – Over the last 2 weeks, typhoon Yagi, Asia's strongest storm in 2024 made landfall along the coast of China's Hainan province on 4 Sep (Straits Times, 6 Sep), and northern Vietnam on 7 Sep (12 Sep). In Hainan, there were widespread power outages and shut many schools and businesses. Thankfully most power outages were restored on 6 Sep. In Vietnam though, several Hanoi districts remain inundated on 12 Sep. Floods and landslides also continue to affect many areas, with at least 197 people reported killed and another 128 missing since the storm struck (Straits Times, 12 Sep). Prav for those whose homes and lives have been devastated by super typhoon Yagi, that they may receive the help that they need and comfort.

Come & Help Us

Over the past 10 years, several pastors in the BP denomination have made much intentional effort to get to know one another, to build up trust amongst the churches.

Thankfully, those efforts are slowly bearing fruit. Other than the official events, we are now doing our best to share resources and expertise, wherever possible.

Yet I believe we can do more. We need to start sharing or even sending people.

All of us are working for the One church, with our One Lord Jesus Christ as its head. All of us labour for the same kingdom and the same harvest. As such, I believe the successes and struggles of every church matter to God, and thus should matter to us.

We have recently received appeals from two or three sister churches to help them in a more substantial way. While we can advise or provide financial aid, I think what they really need, is what all churches really need — people. Particularly, willing and mature Christians who can go over to those churches (even for a season) to build relationships, serve the brothers and sisters there, assist with their inreach and outreach efforts, etc.

While this is in no way a simple or straightforward process, we've already seen the fruits of this with our current efforts. Having just 5-6 people go over our sister church for a year has made a noticeable difference. *Imagine what 50 persons could do!*

As such, I am right now appealing on behalf of these churches for ZB members to 'come and help us'. We intend to be more intentional about this as we enter 2025 – our <u>#getsent</u>: <u>Missional Communities</u> year, where **our overall emphasis will be on going**.
