Gospel Culture – Walking in the Light

1 John 1:1-10

'Gospel Culture' - The Hope vs. The Reality

Gospel Culture – in all our gatherings, we hear the good news that Jesus died and rose for sinners like us, so that we vulnerably confess about our sins and struggles to each other and walk confidently together with Him.

Gospel Culture according to 1 John 1

- 1. "Beloved children, we already have fellowship with God!" (v. 1-4)
- 2. "Beloved children, we are in relationship with a God who is light" (v. 5)
- 3. "So, let us boldly walk together in the LIGHT... and not in DARKNESS!" (v. 6-10)





- Fellowship with one another (v. 7)
- Forgiveness by Jesus' blood (v. 7)
- Forgiveness as God promised (v. 9)





- Lying & not practicing truth (v. 6)
- Claiming to have no sin (v. 8, 10)
- Really saying that God is a liar (v. 10)

A Closing Reflection & Prayer

Reflect: What is holding you back from "walking in the light"?

Ask the Lord for help: "Father, You are light. Shine in my heart, show me my darkness and sins. Help me believe this good news that I can walk in the light with you and with others."

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Gospel culture rests on knowing what the gospel is what is the gospel based on 1 John 1?
- 2. Why is it so easy for God's children to say "we have fellowship with him" while we walk in darkness" (1:6) and in hidden sin? How true is this for you personally?
- 3. How can your AG be a place for "walking in the light" where it is a safe and healthy space to confess sins and claim the promise of the Father's sure forgiveness in Christ?

Terusan - Pray for the Badminton Tournament this evening (19 Jan) at Terusan, that it fosters fellowship, strengthens relationships, and builds connections with the Tamil-speaking community, paving the way for faith conversations and a Tamil worship service.

Mission Teams Retreat – This past
Saturday, the Foreign Missions, Home

Our World

Nepal – Pray for a brother who is living in a remote part of West Nepal to serve his home village. He faces challenges as believers are not usually welcomed there. Pray that this brother and his family would persevere in loving and being light to this village for Christ. Pray for God's protection and strength in the midst of opposition to their presence here.

Lebanon – Pray for wisdom and discernment for the nation's newly appointed president and prime minister as they navigate the ongoing economic crisis and the the ceasefire between Israel-Hezbollah. Pray for guidance in implementing policies that bring economic stability, reduce poverty, and foster sustainable development as they prioritise the needs of the people. May God continue to uphold peace, particularly in maintaining the ceasefire with Israel, and for fostering unity and reconciliation within the region.

Gaza ceasefire – Thank God that Israel and Hamas have reached a ceasefire deal last Wednesday. This ends 15 months of war in Gaza (ST, 16 Jan). Pray that the peace would hold and the various phases of the implementation of the peace process will occur so that healing can come to both sides in the conflict. May believers in this region be empowered by the Spirit to bring God's peace to the communities shattered by war and hatred.

The Next Lap Continues...

Two weeks ago, the Next Lap leadership team had a day retreat. We spent a few hours going through the Vision, to reflect on what we had been hearing from God and His Word, and to co-discern the path moving forward.

We agreed that we should press on with our current 3-fold vision over the next few years, to ensure that every member becomes mature in Christ. Ideally...

- (1) Each person that joins Zion Bishan, joins an AG, anchored under a specific Congregation, where they can be personally discipled by a trained leader proficient in handling the Word of God (#getdeep).
- (2) Each AG becomes a place that reflects a gospel culture: where we welcome and interact with one another as saints loved by God; sufferers with areas of real brokenness; and sinners with specific and ongoing sins (#getreal).
- (3) Each AG should strive to be a place where people are eventually sent out to minister to others either within the congregation, the church, the denomination, the neighbourhood or even to the nations (#getsent).

More than that, the pastors agreed that while it is good to keep growing in number and size (thanks be to God!), we don't want to hoard our growth. We want to be aggressive about sharing our blessings with the denomination and the wider kingdom. We want to keep using our resources to serve others. At the same time, we also want to start sending out people to wherever there is need, and to whomever asks for help. We want to give away our fruit!

Indeed, I feel personally encouraged, inspired and challenged by fellow leaders with such a heart and such a selfless (and hopefully Christ-like) vision!

May God bless the work of our hands!
